RE: GREATER BRISBANE 3 DAY LOCKDOWN

Dear Retail Partner,

The QLD Government has this morning announced Greater Brisbane will go into lockdown for three days from 5pm tonight, Monday 29 March 2021, until 5pm on Thursday night.

During this lockdown people who have been in the Greater Brisbane region since Saturday 20 March, in the local government areas of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, Moreton Bay and Redlands will be required to stay at home except for essential reasons, such as:

- Shopping for essentials, food and necessary supplies
- Medical or healthcare needs, including compassionate requirements
- Providing care or assistance to an immediate family member

Masks will also need to be worn indoors everywhere in these local government areas (except if you are at home), and it is strongly advised that masks are worn outdoors if you are unable to stay more than 1.5m distance from other people (such as busy walkways and thoroughfares). You can remove your mask to consume food or drink. Children 12 years and under and people affected by a medical condition are exempt.

During this lockdown, the centre will be open with the below restrictions which are in line with QLD Government advice:


- Masks are to be worn at all times within the centre, including in the carpark.
- Restaurants, cafes and the food court will provide takeaway and delivery service only. Seating in the food court will not be available.
- Cinemas, entertainment, recreation venues and the gym will be closed.
- Hairdressers, spas, nail salons, beauty salons, waxing salons, and tanning salons will be closed.
- All businesses that remain open must operate within their COVID-Safe Plan.
- Children's play equipment will be closed.

We continue to remain diligent in our cleaning processes, focussing on key areas such as hard surfaces and bathrooms. Additionally, we have hand sanitisers located at all entrances for customers and retailers to utilise. We've also increased signage and additional security to ensure physical distancing, the wearing of masks and other government measures continue to be observed by everyone.
