**RE: QLD CHANGES TO COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

Dear Retail Partner,

The QLD Government have announced Greater Brisbane will go into lockdown for three days from 6pm Friday 8 January until 6pm Monday 11 January, while contact tracers work to ensure the UK strain of COVID-19 is not circulating in the community.

During this lockdown people in the local government areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan will be required to stay at home except:

- Shopping for essentials, food and necessary supplies
- Medical or healthcare needs, including compassionate requirements
- Exercise with no more than one other person, unless all from the same household
- Providing care or assistance to an immediate family member
- Work, or volunteering, or study if it is not reasonably practicable to work or learn remotely
- Child custody arrangements or Legal obligations
- Visit for end of life or to attend funeral
- Weddings in line with restrictions

**Masks will also need to be worn everywhere in those local government areas except if people are at home.** Children 12 years and under and people affected by a medical condition are exempt.

During this lockdown, the centre will be open with the below restrictions for the centre which is in line with QLD Government advice:

- Masks are to be worn at all times within the centre including in the carpark
- Restaurants, Food Courts and Cafes to provide takeaway and delivery service only. Seating in Food Courts will not be available
- Cinemas, entertainment, recreation venues and gyms will be closed
- Hairdressers, spas, nail salons, beauty salons, waxing salons, tattoo parlours and tanning salons will be closed
- All businesses that can remain open must adhere to one person per 4 square metres, and a maximum of 20 to 50 people for businesses operating under a COVID Safe or Industry Plan
- Children's play equipment will be closed.

The full list of restrictions as communicated by the QLD Government include:

- No more than two visitors to the household per day (in addition to anyone else currently staying in the household), excluding care workers or volunteers
- All businesses that can remain open must adhere to one person per 4 square metres, and a maximum of 20 to 50 people for businesses operating under a COVID Safe or Industry Plan
- Restaurants, cafes and Food Courts to provide takeaway and delivery services only

- Cinemas, entertainment and recreation venues, gyms etc to close
- Places of worship to close
- Weddings involve a maximum of 10 people, including the celebrant and witnesses
- Funerals involve a maximum of 20 people
- Mandatory mask wearing anywhere outside of your home
- No visitors to aged care facilities, hospitals, disability accommodation services or correctional facilities.

We continue to remain diligent in our cleaning processes and continue to focus on key areas such as hard surfaces and bathrooms. Additionally, we have hand sanitisers located at all entrances for customers and retailers to utilise. We've also increased signage and additional security to ensure physical distancing, the wearing of masks and other government measures continue to be observed by everyone.
